US Ski and Snowboard Alpine Officials who are certified as Technical Delegate, Referee, Jury Advisor, Chief of Race, and Chief of Course, Timing & Calculations & Race Administrators are required to attend Continuing Education Clinic every two years. This clinic will specialize in preparing coaches who are interested in serving as a Referee.

If you are new to officiating and plan on attending this clinic for training and testing in a specialty area, you will need to complete the online Competition Official course.
