EVENT OVERVIEW

The McCall Winter Sports Club (MWSC) Board of Directors, together with our community health partners, seek to safely execute the 76th Annual Chris Bodily Memorial 3-Way Races on February 14 and 15, 2021. The following outlines the event series format and the plan to safely disperse competitors at each venue and discourage congregation at the start/finish line and implement practices to mitigate the spread of COVID infection.

In order to safely and successfully pull off the event, MWSC has chosen to cancel the Cross Country race this year. The 3 events for 2021 include Slalom, Giant Slalom and Gelande Jump.

Participation in the Alpine events require a USSA Competitor Membership.

Racers, volunteers, spectators, and supporters will be required to wear face coverings and distance themselves 6' from others in the vicinity of the start/finish area and in the venue. The exceptions is when physically skiing/racing a mask is not required and when with members of your household 6' distancing is not required for those in your household.

Racer Check-In Packet and website will kindly request participation in the event be limited to race participants and volunteers and limit spectating if possible. Visit mwsc.club/3-way for more information.

Racer Check-In Packets will be given to coaches for each of their athletes. Coaches may arrange for a pick-up time Saturday evening. Otherwise they may pick up Sunday morning, February 14. Coaches are responsible for distributing the packets to each of their athletes. Racer packet includes race bib for the duration of the races Sunday and Monday, lift tickets, Competitor Communications including schedule and COVID Policies, and a parking permit (one per household) for Little Ski Hill. NOTE: Each bib not returned will be charged \$50 to the athlete's team.

COVID Protocols require that all participants complete a Pre-Screening COVID-19 Questionnaire 24-48 hours prior to February 14, 2021. All participants must also complete a Daily Health Check between 6am and 8am the morning of February 14 and February 15. Athletes, Coaches, Officials and Volunteers may not compete or participate in any way without a Health Check that clears them to participate.

All participants must follow [Brundage Mountain Resort](#) and Little Ski Hill COVID protocol.

No Awards Ceremony will be held following the event and racers and spectators will be encouraged to leave the area as quickly as possible.

Race registration will be cut off on February 11 or when 100 racers have registered (max of 50 women, 50 men). No more than 100 athletes will compete. No day-of registration even if there are fewer than 100 athletes pre-registered.

All volunteers will be supplied face coverings and hand sanitizer. Athletes, Coaches and Parents are required to bring their own mask and PPE.

Parking at each venue is limited! Each household with a participating athlete(s) will receive one parking permit for Little Ski Hill. Without a parking permit, a \$20 parking fee will be collected based on availability. Additional parking is not guaranteed at Little Ski Hill. We encourage households to carpool in one vehicle.

LOCATION: Little Ski Hill, 3635 ID-55, McCall ID 83638

COURSE: Jump, skier's left of Race Run

PARKING: Parking is limited at Little Ski Hill(LSH) to 50 vehicles! Each household is limited to one parking permit and will be received with Racer Check-In Packets. Once 50 vehicles are parked additional vehicles will be charged \$20 if space allows. Otherwise, the Five-Minute Drop-Off zone may be used for a maximum of 5 minutes! There is public parking X mile North at the Winter Trailhead Parking and X miles South in the City of McCall; including the McCall Transit Parking next to Ridley's. ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE: Women, please do not arrive at Little Ski Hill any earlier than 8:30AM. Men, please do not arrive at Little Ski Hill any earlier than 2:30PM.

LODGE: The LSH Lodge is open with limited use, 9AM-8PM. Athletes, coaches, volunteers, parents and supporters may not meet or congregate inside the Lodge or outside on the deck. The Lodge is open for use of the restrooms(downstairs and accessible from the snow-front). The Lodge is open for food and beverage(upstairs inside and outside on the deck). No bag storage in the Lodge allowed.

LIFT TICKETS: Racer Lift Tickets must be pre-purchased at time of race registration. Racers will receive their lift ticket with their Racer Check-In Packet, from their Coach. INSPECTION & REQUIRED TRAINING JUMP: Competitors will get an Inspection run, grouped by team. Inspection is 30 minutes. Competitors are required to complete a Training Jump in order to participate in the competition. The Training Jump will not be measured. Training is 30 minutes.

TWO JUMPS FOR DISTANCE: Competitors will get two jumps. The longest distance of the two jumps will be used to figure results.

START: Start times will be ordered by age, then team. Teams will have a designated staging zone in the course start area. These zones will be spaced out 8-10' from each other. At any one time, only one athlete will be on deck, one athlete will be on the start ramp and one athlete will be in the course including in the finish corral. NOTE: Once the 2nd Jump is complete, Slalom Inspection begins with little time or no time between.

SPECTATORS: Limited spectators are allowed on the snow, below the Jump (bottom of Race Run, 5-minute walk from Lodge). We ask that no more than one parent or guardian per athlete be present. Social distancing and face masks required.

LIVE STREAMING: Jump competition will stream on Facebook Live to encourage others to watch from home.

PARKING: Parking is limited at Little Ski Hill(LSH) to 50 vehicles! Each household is limited to one parking permit and will be received with Racer Check-In Packets. Once 50 vehicles are parked additional vehicles will be charged \$20 if space allows. Otherwise, the Five-Minute Drop-Off zone may be used for a maximum of 5 minutes! There is public parking X mile North at the Winter Trailhead Parking and X miles South in the City of McCall; including the McCall Transit Parking next to Ridley's. ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE: Once the 2nd run is complete, we ask that racers promptly leave Little Ski Hill. Women are expected to finish at 1:45PM. If you have a vehicle in the lot, please depart by 2:15PM to make space for the Men.

LODGE: The LSH Lodge is open with limited use. Athletes, coaches, volunteers, parents and supporters may not meet or congregate inside the Lodge or outside on the deck. The Lodge is open for use of the restrooms(downstairs and accessible from the snow-front). The Lodge is open for food and beverage(upstairs inside and outside on the deck). No bag storage in the Lodge allowed.

LIFT TICKETS: Racer Lift Tickets must be pre-purchased. Racers will receive their lift ticket with their Racer Check-In Packet, from their Coach. FACE MASK: Racers will wear face coverings in the race venue; including at the start and finish. They may remove their mask when on deck for the start and for the duration of their run. Once they cross the finish line they must put their mask up.

INSPECTION & TWO RUNS: Racers will get an inspection run and two timed runs through the course. Inspections will be grouped by team. Start times will be ordered by age, then team.

START: Teams will have a designated staging zone in the course start area. These zones will be spaced out 8-10' from each other. At any one time, only one athlete will be on deck, one athlete will be on the start line and one athlete will be in the course including in the finish corral.

SPECTATORS: Limited spectators are allowed on the snow, outside the Lodge. We ask that no more than one parent or guardian per athlete be present. Social distancing and face masks required. NOTE: Men will race under the lights in evening, so it will be cold and dark for spectators!

LIVE STREAMING: Races will stream on Facebook Live to encourage others to watch from home.

GIANT SLALOM(GS)

LOCATION: Brundage Mountain Resort, 3890 Goose Lake Rd, McCall ID 83638

COURSE: Alpine, accessible via BlueBird Chair

PARKING: Parking is first come, first served. The upper lot is nearest to the BlueBird Chair, but additional parking is located in Centennial Lot and the Goose Lake Lot(overflow).

LODGE: The Lodge is open for food and beverage with limited seating and/or take-out. Visit [Brundage.com](https://brundage.com) for dining options, rental/retail and guest services. No bag storage in the Lodge allowed. Locker rentals available.

Racers will receive their lift ticket with their Racer Check-In Packet, from their Coach. Parent may purchase a discounted (20% off) ticket at the Ticket Window WITH A PARENT TICKET VOUCHER! Brundage Mountain Parent Ticket Vouchers must be reserved by emailing mccallwintersportsclub@gmail.com by February 11th. If you do not reserve a Ticket Voucher by February 11th you will not be guaranteed a lift ticket as day ticket quantities are limited. LIFT LOAD: Athletes and coaches may load the BlueBird Chair at 8:45AM with proof of competing/coaching (ie: Bib, Racer Lift Ticket, Arm Badge). Lift starts turning at 9AM for general public. There are no dedicated lift lines or cutting allowed for racers or coaches.

FACE MASK: Racers will wear face coverings in the race venue; including at the start and finish. They may remove their mask when on deck for the start and for the duration of their run. Once they cross the finish line they must put their mask up.

INSPECTION & TWO RUNS: Racers will get an inspection run and two timed runs through the course. Inspections will be grouped by team. Start times will be ordered by gender, age, then team.

START: Teams will have a designated staging zone in the course start area. These zones will be spaced out 8-10' from each other. At any one time, only one athlete will be on deck, one athlete will be on the start line and one athlete will be in the course including in the finish corral.

SPECTATORS: The course is only accessible by skis/snowboard and requires a lift ticket or season pass. Foot passes will not be sold and no foot traffic is allowed. We ask that no more than one parent or guardian per athlete be present. Social distancing and face masks required.

LIVE STREAMING: Races will stream on Facebook Live to encourage others to watch from home.
