**Lifts:** \$44.52per day or \$89.04 for two-day series (checks payable to Bogus Basin Mountain Recreation). Bogus Basin has installed new RFID ticket system. **Please complete the ticket order form and return it to info@bbsef.org by February 5.** The RFID cards with the racer's names will be available to pickup with their bibs at the JHTC. Pay by check, when you pick up bibs at the JHTC. If you have a pull from the race and the ticket is not used, you will be able to request a refund.
